EARLY YEARSFOUNDATION STAGE

Pre-Primary


The Foundation Stage is for children 2.5 years to 6 years of age and is designed to be a comfortable bridge between starting school to getting into mainstream academic curriculum. It provides a broad curriculum based on the specific areas of learning and development which are Personal, Social and Emotional Developments.

Children also learn to foster relationships, develop self-confidence and self-awareness and manage feelings and behavior. Our safe and inspiring natural setting encourages wonder and joy so as to support each child to explore and make sense of their world. They actively engage in activities for hands-on experiences so that they find their own strengths and interests. The Program focuses on building their foundation with key skills to enable and prepare them for future learning.

Primary School

Here the child will be exposed to aslightly more formal and structured environment of school. Grade I to V offers a holistic learning environment with a meaningful and child-centred inquiry program. We encourage students to be curious and confident through active participation in a creative, challenging and dynamic learning environment.





Middle School

Middle School is a critically defining point in a student's educational career that focuses on the development of student identity and student well-being. Emphasis is placed upon exploration and building curiosity. At Middle School, students begin to take more responsibility for their learning and the teacher performs the role of a facilitator. Students have ample opportunities to explore, fine-tune and exhibit their talents. We acknowledge that all subject areas are connected and therefore, we lay special emphasis on integration across subjects to make learning more meaningful and relevant.

Secondary and Senior Secondary

As students reach Secondary classes and transition from Secondary to Senior Secondary, we continue to build upon the elements that make learning fully connected across all disciplines. In keeping with the demands of the 21st Century, our instructional practices are designed to provide students with a framework for critical analysis, research, collaboration, and presentation skills. All streams such as Science, Commerce and Humanities are catered to and proper care is taken to create a central curriculum that is supported by a wide variety of academic and cultural activities, lectures, debates and exhibitions.



LEARNINGJOURNEY

A child's learning journey is recorded from the moment he or she enrol in the first year at our school. The evidence is gathered from the observations that take place during formal and informal activities. This can include annotated photographs, notes from observations, detailed learning stories and examples of children's work. This evidence is used to assess and ensure that the planned activities are meeting the child's interests and needs.



ASSESSMENT

School progressively allows more space to learning outcome based assessment in place of textbook driven assessment. Question papers have more questions based on real life situations requiring students to apply, analyze, evaluate and synthesize information as per the stipulated out comes. This eliminates predictability and rote learning to a large extent.

One time year-end examination is complimented and supplemented with internal assessment that assesses students in a diverse manner at different times and also examines a broad range of curriculum objectives. Along with regular periodic test, multiple assessment strategies relevant to particular learning outcomes are advised over the period of curriculum transaction. Subject enrichment activities are conducted with rigor and focus. Teacher uses this opportunity to full advantage and use excerpts from relevant suitable literature to develop vocabulary and heighten student's awareness and sensitivity. Thus we support the personalized needs of the learners and foster active learning. Besides we manage staff and workload effectively last but not the least we foster a motivated learning community.



BEYOND THE CURRICULUM

At BZS, we believe that extra-curricular opportunities are important for promoting creative thinking and artistic aptitude to enrich the students. We offer various activities, such as student exchange programs also, for students to engage in better communication, planning and giving pupils a practical approach about how their skills translate into the real world.

We place great emphasis upon communication and personal, social and emotional development as these underpin everything else that is taught. Opportunities differ from term to term and across various classes catering to the specific needs of the child.


NATIONAL CADET CORPS(NCC) A SENSE OF PRIDE


